Civil Protection Orders: A Guide for Improving Practice (CPO Guide) Technical Assistance and Training Project

**Summary**

This project provides training and technical assistance for communities and professionals, including judges, law enforcement officers, advocates, civil attorneys, and prosecutors, on implementing the provisions of the the project's community tool, "Civil Protection Orders: A Guide for Improving Practice" (CPO Guide), which includes three supplements to the CPO Guide, one for court personnel, one for probation officers, and a practice guide on child-related relief in civil protection orders. In addition to providing training and technical assistance on the CPO Guide, this project also provides training and technical assistance around issues such as full faith and credit, victim autonomy, contextualizing requested relief, inter-state child custody, firearms prohibitions, compliance review hearings, and issuance, service, and enforcement of civil protection orders.
