









Print OVC's Child Victims and Witnesses Support Materials

The <u>Child Victims and Witnesses Support Materials</u> intend to support child victims and witnesses as they interact with the justice system. Illustrated narratives featuring child and adolescent characters are available for different age groups and different environments, including child welfare, criminal court, human trafficking cases, and Native communities. The materials are available on the Office for Victims of Crime's website for free download.

The booklets are available in several languages including Spanish, Chinese (simplified), Arabic, Vietnamese, and Haitian Creole. The specialized materials for survivors of human trafficking are also available in Spanish, Chinese (simplified), Vietnamese, Brazilian Portuguese, and African French.

To further assist national distribution and use of these materials, agencies can apply for printed materials up to \$10,000 worth.

 Applications for this opportunity will be accepted from agencies that work directly with child victims and witnesses.

 Priority will be given to agencies that are either based in rural areas or Tribal lands, or who work directly with child victims and witnesses in rural or Native American communities, and who demonstrate a clear need for this printing opportunity.
