

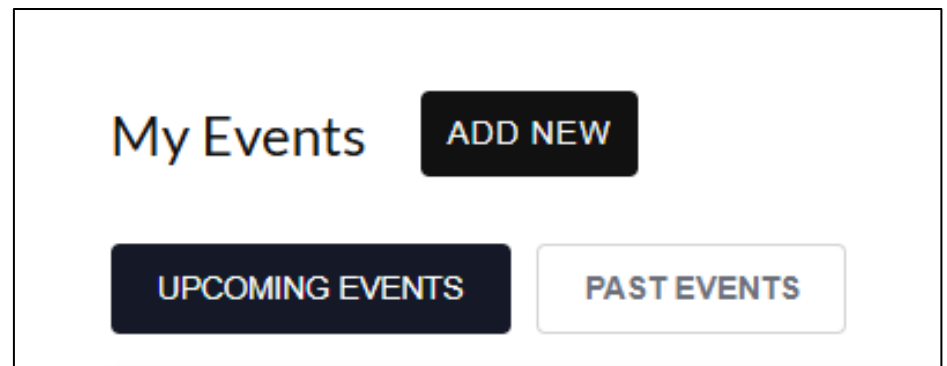

TEMPLATE:

EXAMPLE:

The National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges and Futures Without Violence presents a three-day workshop for state and tribal court judges and judicial officers who are seeking to develop their skills in handling criminal and civil cases involving domestic violence. This highly interactive, peer-to-peer educational program offers segments on practical courtroom exercises that consist of role-plays or hypothetical cases and that require participants to take judicial action or make judicial decisions; the dynamics of domestic violence, including victim and perpetrator behaviors; fact-finding and how to gather and process factual information needed to make a decision; access to justice and the role of judges in their courtrooms and communities; fairness and cultural issues that arise in domestic violence cases; and applying the law to facts in these cases.

LIBRARY






